“That Kilkenny Municipal District Council would initiate the development of a conservation and enhancement plan for the lane ways of Kilkenny City. Such a plan would require the use of participative planning methodologies with residents, retailers and the general public to devise a set of actions around the enhancement, interpretation and use of the lanes into the future. This motion in particular recognises the historic significance of the market slip, butterslip, St Mary's lane, Abbey Street, St Canice's Cathedral precinct and New Building lane and seeks to introduce best conservation practices in conserving heritage features and the remaining tudor houses in the city.”
